

MINUTES OF A MEETING OF OULTON PARISH COUNCIL
held on Tuesday 29th April 2014

1. Present: Mr. P. Killingback, Mr. A. Nash, Mr. G. Peck, Ms. N. Poole, Ms. A. Shaw.

Apologies: Mr. S. Booker

In attendance: Mr. D. Harrison

2. Declarations of Interest: There were no declarations of interest

3. Minutes: Minutes of the meeting held on the 18th March were approved and signed.

4. Matters Arising: Potholes in Hall Road: Following emails between the County Council and the Clerk, Ms. Poole will talk to Quentin Barker of NCC.

Allotment: The Clerk will contact Sadie Harrold to ask her to remove the rubble and restack the roofing sheets. She will also contact Simon Dunford to see if he still wishes to use the allotment.

5. Planning Applications: The formal response to the AD in Oulton Street had been made to the Planning Inspectorate and the Chairman and Ms. Shaw attended the meeting. It seemed very fair and the Inspector listened to all the views expressed and conducted discussions fairly. She and those in attendance then visited the AD at Taverham and then carried onto the proposed site in Oulton Street where further discussions were held. The result of the appeal could be as late as August.

Application 20140335 for 6 Biomass Boilers and Fuel Stores (Re-submission) at Oulton Airfield for Bernard Matthews Ltd. Broadland DC were not prepared to put a section 106 on Oulton Street to prevent lorries using that section of the road which contained houses bearing in mind that the LPG deliveries already used that route. They agreed that there should be no night-time deliveries.

6. Financial Matters: A cheque was signed for £81.53 being the annual subscription to the Norfolk Association of Local Councils.

The accounts would be presented at the next meeting – in the meantime the Clerk would send copies of the audit form and other relevant papers to all councillors.

7. Report from David Harrison: He reported that the Kings Lynn incinerator had been cancelled on monetary grounds. The Northern Distributor route was going to a planning enquiry.

9. AD at Aylsham Planning Application 20140630: Members of the Parish Council were asked if the Council should make comments on this planning application. It was decided that Oulton PCs comments on traffic movements should be sent to Aylsham Town Council; that members should attend the ATC meeting;

that information including traffic movements and comments from DEFRA regarding Government policy on ADs and any other relevant information should be sent to parish councils of surrounding villages. The Chairman and Ms. Shaw will prepare a letter which the Clerk will send out. Furthermore this parish will make a response to the application.

10. Date of the next Meeting: This will be held on Tuesday 20th May 2014 and will be the Annual General Meeting, followed by the Annual Village Meeting.
