

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF OULTON PARISH COUNCIL
held at Oulton Congregational Chapel on Tuesday 21st June 2016

2. Minutes: The minutes of the Annual General Meeting held on the 10th May were signed and approved.

3. Declarations of Interest: Mr. Peck and Ms Harrison declared a non-prejudicial interest in item 5 in that they were members of the National Trust. There were no other declarations.

4. Matters Arising: Planning Application 20160323 Conversion of Former Chapel to a Dwelling and change of use of land at the Street, Oulton. This has been passed by BDC.

5. Planning Applications: Application number 20160999 Construction of Multi-use Trail within Blickling Park including upgrading of existing surfaced track and paths; resurfacing of existing compacted earthpaths; widening of existing surfaced paths; construction of new trail to make a circular route. The Parish Council had no objection to this application.

6. Financial Matters: A cheque was signed for £256.55 to Zurich Municipal for the three-year agreement covering the Parish Council's insurance. A cheque was also signed for £80.00 to Norfolk Historic Buildings Trust being the rent for 8 meetings held at the Chapel.
The Clerk received a cheque for £100 from Mr. Peck covering the rent for the marquee.

7. Any Other Business: Pond in the Street – residents had enquired whether it would be possible to have a bench on the far side of the pond. The Chairman would speak to the Harrolds.

At the Village Meeting the question had been asked whether it would be possible to have deer signs on the road through the wood. The Clerk had asked NCC and the matter was being considered.

8. Date of the next meeting: This will be held on Tuesday 2nd August
